



STANDBRED NATIONAL HIGH POINT COMPETITION 2017-2018

Members of the Standardbred Pleasure Associations, in Australia, are invited to take part in this exciting national, members-only, competition. The competition has 2 JUNIOR sections for younger members showing mares or geldings and 3 SENIOR sections for members, 18 years and over, showing mares, geldings or stallions. Your Horse must be registered with SPPHA NSW be eligible to compete.

Each participating state association has nominated 4 shows that offer led and ridden classes that lead to a Supreme Led Standardbred Exhibit sash presentation and a Ridden Champion Standardbred sash presentation.

The shows for New South Wales are:

- Penrith Show 27th August 2017 (Penrith Showground)
- Cootamundra Show 21st October 2017 (Cootamundra Showground)
- Luddenham Show 17th February 2018 (Luddenham Showground)
- Hawkesbury Show 21st April 2018 (Hawkesbury Showground, Clarendon)

To be eligible to contest this competition, you need to fill in the entry form at the bottom of this sheet and return it with entry fees of \$20 for each section you wish to contest – either led or ridden or both. The maximum entry fee is \$40

You will be issued with a Standardbred National High Point performance card. This card is to be taken to each of the 4 shows, where you are to record your placings and have the card signed by the judge or ring steward. All cards are to be returned to the SPPHA NSW by 30th June 2018. Unsigned cards will be deemed unacceptable.

Point allocations will be as follows:

1 st place	4 points	Supreme	10 points	These points are not accumulative. The horse that is awarded a Supreme can only achieve 10 points, a Champion 8 points, a Reserve 6 points. 1 st place and no Champion, or Supreme will achieve 4 points, etc.
2 nd place	3 points	Champion	8 points	
3 rd place	2 points	Reserve	6 points	
4 th place	1 point			

Achievement sashes will be presented to the Top 5 in each section as follows:

Juniors – handler/rider to be under 18 years of age on 1 July 2017

Junior Led Gelding Junior Led Mare
Junior Ridden Gelding Junior Ridden Mare

Seniors – handler/rider to be 18 years or over on 1 July 2017

Senior Led Gelding Senior Led Mare Senior Led Stallion
Senior Ridden Gelding Senior Ridden Mare Senior Ridden Stallion

National Championship sashes will be presented to the led and ridden horses, in each section (junior and senior), with the highest points. National High Point Performance Horse sashes will be presented to the horse, in each section (junior and senior), with the highest combined (led and ridden) points. Depending on the number of entries received, we hope to be able to present shopping voucher prizes to the winners as well. If this competition grows, as we expect it to, so will the value of the prizes returned to the winners.

We are asking all members to please consider taking part in this exciting competition and to fill in the entry form (below) **and return it to SPPHA NSW by 20th August** to have your NHP Performance Card given out at Penrith Show (monies can be given on the day – just call 0414 963 471 to advise if you are entering). **(See other methods of payment on entry Form)**
