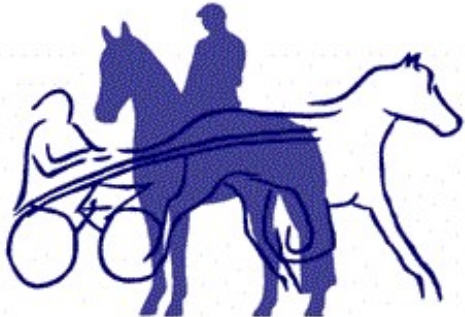

## **Class Rules and Definitions**

- This event is open to all Standardbreds freeze branded and registered with HRA or HRNZ

- Classes will be conducted under the Equestrian Australia Show Horse guidelines and the Standardbred Pleasure and Performance Horse Association of New South Wales Showing Guidelines.
- Age of the horse is from 1<sup>st</sup> September
- Stallions are **only permitted** in Stallion classes
- Riders/Handlers must be over 18 years of age for all Stallions
- Riders age is at the day of the show
- A rider/handler may enter more than one horse; however, this must not hold up any classes.
- Officials will not be asked to hold horses for competitors
- Rider may enter more than one level
- Horses only to enter one ridden level, beginner, novice or open
- **SPPHA NSW Horse Placement** is open to **all** horses placed through SPPHA NSW Horse Placement Program prior to March 2018
- **Beginner** ridden Standardbred is a horse who has **not won more** than 3 beginner ridden Standardbred classes at any agricultural, Equestrian Australia or Show Horse Council show. A horse is **not classified** a beginner if it has been **awarded a Champion or Reserve Champion Ridden Standardbred** at any agricultural, Equestrian Australia or Show Horse Council show. **Beginner** horses are only **expected to walk and trot with no canter**.
- **Novice** ridden Standardbred is a horse who **has won more** than 3 beginner ridden Standardbred classes at any agricultural, Equestrian Australia or Show Horse Council show and **who has not won more than 3 novice ridden Standardbred classes** at any agricultural, Equestrian Australia or Show Horse Council show. **Novice** ridden Standardbred **must not have been award 1<sup>st</sup> place in Open ridden Standardbred Class** at any agricultural, Equestrian Australia or Show Horse Council show. It is expected for a **Novice** ridden Standardbred to be able to **walk, trot and canter**.
- **Open** ridden Standardbred is for any horse who **has won more** than 3 novice ridden Standardbred classes at any agricultural, Equestrian Australia

or Show Horse Council show. **Open** ridden Standardbred is expected to walk, trot, canter and may be asked for simple changes and lengthening.

- **Newcomer**, a newcomer is any horse who has not previously competed under saddle prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018. This is including pony club, adult riding club, endurance, dressage, show jumping, eventing etc.
- **Related** horses refers to entries having the same Sire or the same Dam.

## General Rules

- Protests may be lodged at the show office on the day within 30 minutes of the class with a nonrefundable \$100
- Nominations of this event confirms you have accepted the terms and conditions of entry and guidelines applicable to the event
- No refunds after the closing date without a vet certificate or medical certificate, admin fee will not be deducted

- The Standardbred Pleasure and Performance Horse Association of New South Wales event organizing committee or the Standardbred Pleasure and Performance Horse Association of New South Wales Committee will NOT accept any responsibility for accident, damage, injury or illness to the horses, riders, ground staff, spectators or any other person or property.
- Volunteers on the day are not permitted to be a member of the Standardbred Pleasure and Performance Horse Association of New South Wales but are permitted to sign a waiver form day of helping.
- All horses must be presented drug free for this event or will forfeit any awards and/or prizes on the day of competition and be disqualified for the remaining classes of the event.
- Random drug testing maybe carried out during the event.
- Hendra vaccinations will not be compulsory for this event. However, horse health declaration forms are required for all horses entering the grounds for the event.
- The Standardbred Pleasure and Performance Horse Association of New South Wales organizing committee reserves the right to split and combine classes.
