



CAMPING RULES

All year (outside of Country Music Festival)

HORSES

Paceway Tamworth is a registered training facility for Harness Racing NSW. All campers **MUST** respect the Harness Racing Trainers and their horses and **GIVE RIGHT OF WAY** to the trainers and their horses at **ALL TIMES**. Whilst we do encourage you to enjoy the spectacle of the horses training or racing on the track, please refrain from leaning over the fence, especially during a race meeting – this is for your own safety. **ENTRY TO STABLE AREA IS NOT PERMITTED.**

CAMP SITE DETAILS

All personal belongings should be kept within your designated site area so paths and roads are not obstructed. Pegs must be no longer than 30cm. Vehicles must be clear of all roadways. Failure to do so will result in vehicles being towed at the owners cost.

LOSS OF PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Paceway Tamworth and Harness Racing NSW shall not be liable for any loss or damage to your property by theft or personal injury.

NOISE

Be mindful of other campers. No excessive noise i.e loud radios or generators are permitted before 7am or after 9pm.

VISITORS/CONTRACTORS

All visitors/ contractors wishing to come on site must attend the Paceway Tamworth Office and check in first. All campers must advise staff at Paceway Tamworth Office that they are expecting visitors/ contractor to their site.

USE OF CAMPING FACILITIES

Amenities: There are 2 amenities blocks available within the camping grounds. Each has showers and toilets. All visitors are asked to keep the toilets and showers as clean and tidy as possible. Please use the bins provided in the amenities block. Please turn taps off and do not put articles likely to cause obstructions into the basins, sinks or toilets.

Laundry: There is a washing machine available at Amenities block 5 (cost is \$3 per wash - \$1 coins accepted)

SPEED LIMIT

Please observe a maximum 10kph speed limit at all times.

DOGS

Dogs are permitted in Paceway Tamworth grounds provided they are kept on a lead (maximum length of 1 metre) and under control at all times. Dogs must be kept away from horse activities including the **Harness Racing Track**. **Dogs are strictly prohibited in the amenities block.** Please ensure that dog droppings are disposed of using the waste bins provided.

FIRES

The lighting of fires are strictly prohibited.

RUBBISH

All refuse is to be placed in one of the many appropriately marked rubbish bins provided around Paceway Tamworth. Rubbish bins are not to be removed from the designated locations.

SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted in the designated areas. Smoking is **NOT** permitted in any building on the grounds of Paceway Tamworth.

WATER

We are in drought here in Tamworth. **PLEASE** don't waste water. If you have tanks on your van, we ask that you fill up and disconnect from the tap. Any person seen wasting water by leaving the tap turned on while you are away for the day or if your hose or fittings has a leak – your hose will be confiscated. Turn your taps off when you are away from your van or not using water. Grey water is permitted to be run out onto the ground.

ELECRICITY

For your safety only 15amp power cords with 15 amp terminals are allowed and must be tested & tagged. **There is to be no "piggy backing" of power to sites.** All caravans, campers, trailers must be wired to Australian New Zealand Standards AS/NZS 3001. Any problems with supply to your site, please contact Management immediately – do not try to fix it yourself.

DUMPING OF SULLAGE

Patrons **must not** dump their toilet cassettes in the campgrounds or any of the amenities. Patrons must contain their toilet cassettes and travel to the closest Dump Point located 5 minutes west of the grounds on the Oxley Highway opposite the Tamworth Airport at the Lions Park.

Paceway Tamworth Management reserves the right to ask guests who contravene these rules and regulations or who in any other way are behaving in a manner likely to cause distress or nuisance to other visitors or staff, to leave the grounds immediately with no refund. Paceway Tamworth Management shall not be liable for any extra costs incurred by visitors being evicted. Visitors must not remain on any part of Paceway Tamworth grounds after having been requested to leave.
