

Paceway Tamworth Stable Rules and Regulations.

1. Each vacant stable is locked until such time that a stable has been booked and payment received. A Stabling/ Camping Form (see appendix 1) must be completed by each person booking a stable or a group of stables. Record of forms are retained in Paceway Tamworth Administration files as per Casual Stabling Policy.
2. Once a horse has been allocated to a stable, it **MUST NOT** be moved unless at the permission of Paceway Tamworth Management and the Stable Form is amended to note the move of a horse to another stable.
3. The instructions given by Paceway Tamworth staff must be followed. All signage displayed on the grounds must be adhered to.
4. **All buildings are NO SMOKING ZONES including the Stable Complex, Arenas, Seating Areas**
5. Please ensure enclosed footwear is worn at all times within the stable complex.
6. All children must be under direct adult supervision at all times.
7. The riding of bikes and or scooters are **NOT PERMITTED** in or around the perimeter of the stable complex.
8. All dogs **MUST** be on a lead at all times – No exceptions to this rule.
9. **NO GLASS** is permitted in the camping areas or stable complex. Cans or plastic bottles only.
10. All aisles must be kept clear of all obstructions in case of emergency.
11. Horses should be cared for according to best accepted practice.
12. All feed must be fed in buckets/bins or hay nets if within stable.
13. The use of portable panels or tape fencing is permitted, however must be in an area specified by management and the space used must not exceed 3m x 3m per horse. Any fencing not approved by management will be removed.
14. Stable bedding is provided with approximately 2 cubic metres of Hoop Pine sawdust in each stable. Should more bedding be required, please advise management and more will be provided. Bedding other than that provided by Paceway Tamworth is not permitted to be introduced as per the Bio-Security Policy.
15. Stables are for animal husbandry only. They are not to be used for any sort of retail or human accommodation.
16. Remove any manure or rubbish after using the wash bays.
17. Any Farrier work conducted within the stable complex must be cleaned up on completion. All spent nails must be collected and disposed of in the waste bins provided.
18. If an individual or Event Organiser call a vet onsite to treat a sick or injured horse, Paceway Tamworth Management **MUST** be contacted immediately in compliance with the Bio-Security Policy. A detailed Veterinary Report must be sent to Paceway Tamworth of any Notifiable Diseases found.
19. **If a horse shows any sign of sickness before arrival to Paceway Tamworth, it must not be transported onsite.**
20. On departure, please remove all manure, urine stain and feed scraps. All waste must be disposed of in the manure bays provided. The stables will be inspected by Paceway Tamworth staff after departure and the stable bond will be refunded if the stable is left in a clean condition. If a stable is left unclean the stable bond will not be refunded and the hirer will be informed as such.
21. Accidents, incidents and damages – Please report all incidents, accidents and damages to the Paceway Tamworth Management. We are committed to providing a safe environment for all users. Should you observe or experience anything that you feel compromises your health and safety please report this to management as soon as possible.
22. Vehicles are not permitted to be parked within the Stable Complex.
23. The placement or affixing of advertising material (including posters), is not permitted without approval in writing by Paceway Tamworth Management.
